Auskick Teams

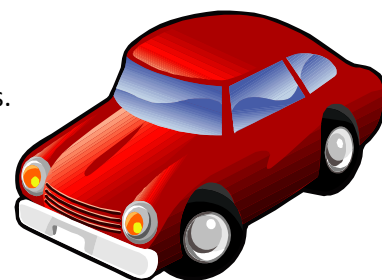
Our busy Auskick brigade led by Sam Dawson have done a great job in dividing the kids into squads and appointed coaches.
