Ground Lighting Project

Many would be aware that Marist Football Club has embarked upon a project to install ground lighting to our main centre oval. Committee member Michael Milne with the invaluable assistance of player parent Mike Lovegrove (Lovegrove Electrical) initially focused on 2 x 20m flood light towers on the far side of the oval to allow night time training, however, with the support of Newman College, the WA Football Commission and our generous Sponsors (Lovegrove Electrical in particular), we have progressed the specification to 4 x 25m towers that provides ground lighting sufficient for night time match play. The approvals process is proving to be somewhat more arduous than originally anticipated although it will be well worth the wait in the end. Details - Michael Milne 0403 466 603.
